Robin is an executive, visionary and strategist with a track record of building high-energy organizations. He has over 20 years of experience in the diagnostics and laboratory sector.

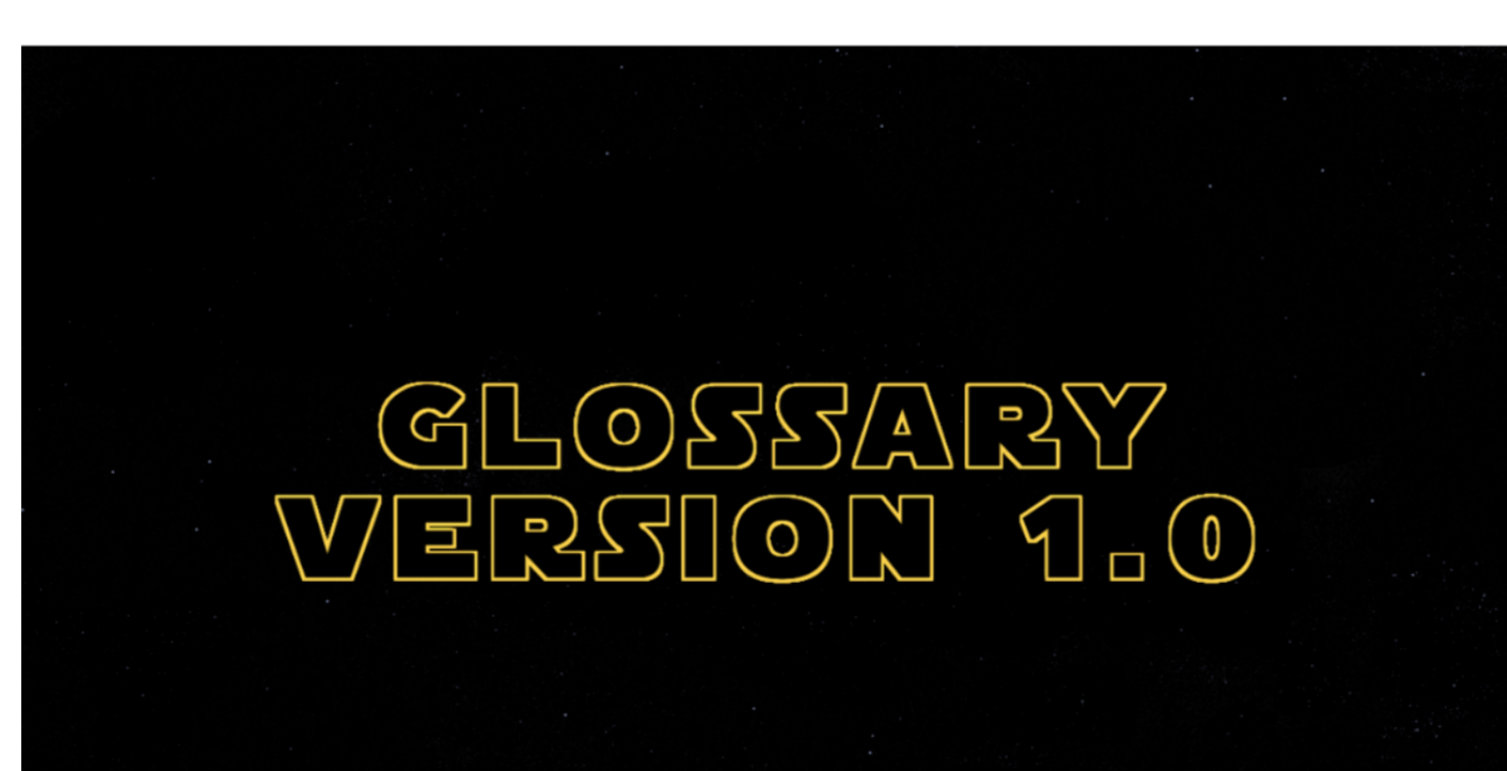

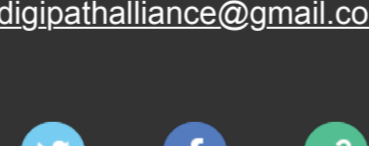

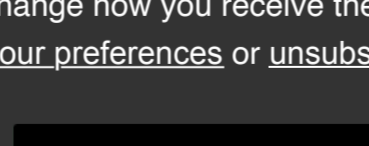
